

**CHAMPIONSHIP FORMATS

VOLLEYBALL, BASKETBALL, SOCCER

‘A’ Boys and Girls – 4 team format

One team from each of the districts 1/7, 8 and 9.

Last year’s winning district (Jr. and Sr.) second place plays College Heights to make the final entry.

If there is no second place team in the winning district, the second team from second place district the previous year is eligible.

For play-down locations check the Host Rotation schedule for CWOSSA Qualifiers.

‘AA’ Boys and Girls – 4 team format

District 1&7 - 2 teams

District 4 - 1 team

District 10 vs District 9 - 1 team

‘AAA’ Boys and Girls – 8 team format

Districts 1 & 7 vs District 4/10 - 2nd place - 1 team

District 9 vs District 5 – 2nd place – 1 team

‘AAAA’ Boys and Girls – 6 team format (2 pools of 3)

District 1&7 – 2 teams

District 10 vs District 4 – 2nd place – 1 team

BOYS

District 1&7 – 2 teams

District 4&10 – 2 teams

District 9 – 2 teams

‘AAA/AAAA’

GIRLS - The tournament for the AAA/AAAA schools will consist of **8** teams.

District 6, 8 & 11 – 3 entries

District 10 – 2 entries

District 1&7 plays off with District 4 - 1 entry

District 5 – 1 entry

District 9 plays off with District 5-2nd – 1 entry

GOLF

Boys - To be decided by the convenor and based on the space available on the golf course.

A ratio is to be determined based on the number of team space available at the course divided by the number of schools in CWOSSA that participate in golf. If the ratio was 50 %, then 50% of the schools participating in each district would gain entry to CWOSSA. The convenor may have to round the entry, up or down. Local entries should be decided by local tournaments.

Girls – a. To be decided by the convenor and based on the space available on the golf course.

b. Each District will receive 1 entry per registered school.

c. District entries should be decided by local tournaments.

d. A District may only enter golfers with a score of 120 or less on a minimum par 70 course.

FIELD HOCKEY

Eight Teams

One entry from District 8

One from District 1 & 7 combined

One from District 10

Three teams from the pooled District 6 & 11 (4 if no GBSSAA team)

One entry from GBSSAA (as per OFSAA request)

One from a qualifying game between 2nd place team from District 10 vs. 2nd place team from Dist 8.

TRACK & FIELD

District 1 and 7 - 4 entries/event/age/sex and 4-relay teams/event.

District 5 - 2 entries/event/age/sex and 2-relay teams/event.

District 9 - 2 entries/event/age/sex and 2-relay teams/event.

District 4 and 10 - 4 entries/event/age/sex and 4-relay teams/event.

District 6 and 11 - 4 entries/event/age/sex and 4-relay teams/event.

District 8 - 2 entries/event/age/sex and 2-relay teams/event.

BADMINTON

Each district is allowed two entries in each of the five divisions: Boys' singles, Girls' singles, Boys' doubles, Girls' doubles, and mixed doubles.

A person may participate in only one of the above events.

TENNIS

A player may compete in one event only. Districts 5, 9, and 8 send one entry per event. Districts (1/7), (6/11), (4/10) send two entries per event. If only one school in a district is interested they must compete in the closest district tournament.

SWIMMING

- (a) All entries to the CWOSSA meet shall come from the District Swim Championship meets.
- (b) A school may have a maximum of three (3) competitors in each individual event in each division and one (1) school relay team in each relay event. The only exception is in the 50 m freestyle events in each division, where the number of entries per school is unlimited.
- (c) Competitors may enter up to four (4) events. A maximum of three (3) of these may be individual events.
- (d) Junior swimmers may swim any number of their events in the Senior Division.
- (e) The winner of each event at the District Swim Championship meet may enter the CWOSSA meet, plus any swimmers making the Time Standard for their event.
- (f) For the Open 400 Metre Relay, teams shall consist of four swimmers from the High School Division, the Open Division, or any combination thereof.

- (g) Entries must be received by the CWOSSA Meet Manager by the date and time specified in the entry packages. Late entries will only be accepted if they can be accommodated.
- (h) Relay teams entered in the CWOSSA Championship Meet must have successfully completed the corresponding event at the District Swim Championship Meet. Any relay team disqualified at the District Meet is not eligible to compete at CWOSSA. For relays, it is the school team that qualifies for CWOSSA, but any eligible swimmer may compete on the relay team for that school, regardless of whether they competed at the District Meet.

ALPINE SKIING

Each school shall race a maximum of one boy's and one girl's team in each of Level 1 and 2. Each team shall consist of a maximum of 5 skiers. Entries to Level 3 may be made in addition to the above as numbers permit or entries to Level 3 may be made in lieu of one of the above teams.

NORDIC SKIING

Schools do not have to qualify through their district.

2. All teams have 5 members in the individual race with 4 to count.

3. Schools can enter as many teams as they wish in each division. Individual skiers can be entered where a full team is not available. If more than one team is entered, they must be designated A and B prior to the race. These teams are then considered separate entities for the purpose of competition and scoring.

CROSS COUNTRY

Each school may enter a maximum of 48 runners. There shall be one team per school per classification with a maximum of 8 runners per classification. Four runners' positions count for the team championship in each classification. In the event of a tie, the fourth placed runner nearest first place will be used.

JUNIOR BOYS SOCCER

The tournament will be an 6 team tournament with entries from the following areas:

District 4	1 entry
District 10	1 entry
District 8	1 entry
District 6/11	2 entries
District 5/9	1 entry

If there is no entry from District 5/9, then the host district will receive the entry

WRESTLING

CWOSSA is divided into three areas with three qualifying tournaments.

<i>North</i>	-Guelph and North
<i>Central</i>	-Kitchener/Waterloo area
<i>South</i>	-Brantford area

The conveners exercise the right to adjust areas to insure a quality tournament in each area.

The top 4 advance from the qualifying tournament to CWOSSA (#'s adjusted to run a 12 person draw, double elimination).
