FORMAT: *Round Robin Section*

- 2 out of 3 games
- Rally point scoring with no cap, must win by 2 points
- 3rd game will be to 15 points, no cap, must win by 2 points
- Top 2 teams advance to finals

Finals

- 3 out of 5 games
- Rally point scoring with no cap, must win by 2 points
- 5th game will be to 15 points, no cap, must win by 2 points

TIES: The tie breaking procedures will follow C.W.O.S.S.A. guidelines. These guidelines are on the C.W.O.S.S.A. website and will be discussed at the coaches meeting.

NET RULES: 2.24 m

SUBSTITUTIONS: 12 per team, per game

TEAM ELIGIBILITY:

C.W.O.S.S.A. eligibility sheets (done by AELS) are to be emailed to ian.strachan@ugdsb.on.ca upon qualifying for the tournament. A signed copy (coach, district convener, principal signatures) of this AELS generated eligibility sheet and any transfer sheets are to be brought to the tournament to be given to the convener.

COACH ELIGIBILITY: All members of the coaching staff (*managers, advisors*) up to a maximum of four, must be entered on the roster before each game.

UNIFORMS: Matching tops and shorts (same colour, length, material) must be worn by all team members. Failure to wear a proper uniform may disqualify a player from participation. (*C.W.O.S.S.A. playing regulations*)

BALLS: Teams must supply their own identifiable balls for warmup.

MINOR OFFICIALS:

- Scorers will be provided by Norwell for all games.
- Round Robin games will have Norwell Senior Boys players on the lines
- **Both finals will use carded officials on the lines.**
(*Under extreme circumstances i.e. ill official, a suitable replacement will be used*)

WARMUP: 5-5-5 as long as time permits. (5 common, 5 full court for each team.)

ENTRY FORMAT:

Teams will be slotted into the schedule based on the pre-determined rotation as outlined in the C.W.O.S.S.A. playing regulations.
