

2017 CWOSSA AAA BOYS' VOLLEYBALL CHAMPIONSHIPS

Welcome to the CWOSSA AAA BOYS' Championships. Below is information for **coaches** regarding the event. Information for athletes and parents can be found directly on the website.

Date: Thursday November 16, 2017

Location: University of Waterloo (PAC and Columbia Icefields) for Pool Play and Semi-Finals, Forest Heights CI for both JR and Sr Finals.

Cost: \$300, please make cheques payable to **FOREST HEIGHTS CI**

T-shirts: T-shirts are available for purchase BEFORE the event. Orders must be received by Monday November 13th in order to be processed and ready for the event. Cost is \$20 CASH ONLY per shirt. Please see website for design and order form.

Rules: Volleyball Canada rules will be used with the following exceptions:

- OFSAA tie-breaking will be used. When applying the tie breaking rules, one should follow this sequence:
 1. When two teams are tied, the tie breaking criteria are applied one after the other until the tie is broken;
 2. When three or more teams are tied, the tie breaking criteria are applied one after the other until all teams are ranked.
 - i. If two (2) teams are tied at the end of the preliminary round for positions in the championship playoffs, the team winning the match between the two tied teams shall receive the higher ranking.
 - ii. If three (3) teams are tied at the end of the preliminary round, the following criteria shall be applied to determine their rankings:
 - a. the team having the best ratio of won/lost matches, considering matches played among the tied teams only in pool play, will be ranked higher;
 - b. the team having the best ratio of won/lost sets (games), considering matches played among the tied teams only in pool play, will be ranked higher;
 - c. the team having the best ratio of won/lost sets (games), considering all matches in pool play will be ranked higher;
 - d. the team having the best ratio of points for/against, considering games played between the tied teams in pool play will be ranked higher;
 - e. the team having the best ratio of points for/against, considering all games played in pool play, will be ranked higher.

NO TEAM SHALL BE ELIMINATED FROM CHAMPIONSHIP PLAY BY POINTS.

- iii. If three (3) or more teams are tied for positions to determine who advances to Championship playoffs, the following criteria shall be applied:
 - a. criteria (ii)(a) to (c) above shall be used to determine the higher ranked team;
 - b. the remaining tied teams will play an additional set to 15 points (2 point margin of victory);

c. if more than two teams are tied, then points shall be used to determine who gets the Bye, using criteria (ii)(d) and (e) above. The remaining two teams shall play a 15- point set (2 point margin of victory) and the winner shall play the Bye team in a 15- point set (2 point margin of victory) to determine who advances to Championship play or is eliminated from play.

- Net Height: Junior Boys 2.35 metres Senior Boys 2.43 metres
- Uniforms:
 - All players must wear matching volleyball jerseys with numbers on front and back. At first glance shorts must have the same predominant colouring
 - Failure to wear a proper uniform may disqualify a player from participating.
- Warm Up:
 - Warm-ups will consist of a 5-5-5 format.
 - Five (5) minutes will be a common time for on court warm-up; five (5) minutes for team serving first at net; five (5) minutes for team receiving first at net.
- Game balls will be provided by the convener and must be the official ball used by OFSAA.
- Number of players allowed on the scoresheet is 18.

Protest Committee

1. A protest committee will be comprised of the convener (Lisa Watson or Steve Clutton), the head referee and one other CWOSSA representative (another coach representing a team that is not DIRECTLY involved).
2. Protests must be submitted in writing to the convener within 30 minutes of the end of the match for which the protest is being lodged.

Awards:

- Members of the "Championship" team shall receive *C.W.O.S.S.A. "GOLD" Medallions (18)*.
- Members of the "Finalists" team shall receive *C.W.O.S.S.A. "SILVER" Medallions (18)*.

The school represented by the Championship team shall receive a plaque to be retained by the school for the year.

- Pool games will be 2 out of 3 matches.
- Semi-final games will be 2 out of 3 matches. If CWOSSA is given two OFSAA entries then they will be 3 out of 5 matches.
- Finals will be 3 out of 5 matches with the exception of:
 - a) "A" Junior which will be 2 out of 3 matches.
 - b) If two OFSAA berths the senior final will be 2 out of 3.
- The first two games will be 25-point rally point with no cap. A team must win by 2 points. If a third or fifth deciding game is necessary, it will be a 15-point rally point game with no cap and a team must win by 2 points.
